



Application for W.S. Morcom Rural Boarding Scholarship at Caulfield Campus

Applications close Tuesday, 2nd May 2023

Caulfield Grammar School is pleased to offer the W.S. Morcom Rural Boarding Scholarships to students who would prosper from and contribute to our vibrant residential community. Several of the Scholarships are also specifically for students whose parents' financial means do not currently allow them to send a child to an Independent school. These Scholarships are offered to rural applicants for entry into our school and into the Boarding House in Years 9 to 11 at Caulfield Campus in 2024. The Scholarships apply for the years of a Child's Secondary Schooling and provide part remission of tuition fees and assistance in meeting the cost associated with boarding.

Mr. William Sheridan Morcom was a member of the staff of Caulfield Grammar School for 50 years including a period as a member of the Resident Staff. As Chief of Staff and on occasion Acting Headmaster, he set high standards in the Academic Learning Program, in sport and in the presentation and conduct of students. He was held in high regard by students, parents, staff members and those involved in Educational and Community Service organisations beyond the School.

Morcom House, Caulfield Grammar School has been a boarding school since its foundation in 1881 and offers accommodation for 90 boarding students. It is a co-educational residential setting where great importance is placed on students achieving their academic potential, fostering a sense of personal responsibility and providing a warm, friendly and secure environment that closely mirrors home life. Low staff to student ratios and strong links with the day school, ensure that the boarders' pastoral care needs are met. Students have the opportunity for participation in music, drama, sport, community service and various leadership programs. The school's extensive academic and recreational facilities, when combined with the wonderful suburban location, provides the students with a wealth of opportunity to pursue current and new interests.

The W.S. Morcom Rural Boarding Scholarships will be awarded to students who are able to demonstrate achievement in several fields of endeavour related to school life such as Academic performance, Leadership and Service, The Arts (Performing Arts and/or Visual Arts) and Sport (students should be competing at a representative/regional/State/National level), who will therefore contribute strongly to the boarding community.

Interviews will then be conducted with short listed candidates in Term 2. Financial information will be requested from families at this time. Scholarships will be offered to successful applicants shortly thereafter.
