

Application for General Excellence (Dance, Theatre and Visual Arts) Scholarship - Years 10 & 11

Selection Criteria

General Excellence (Dance, Theatre & Visual Arts) scholarships are open for entry into Years 10 & 11 to applicants who are:

- New or currently enrolled students of Caulfield Grammar School; and
- A Citizens or Permanent Resident of Australia at the time of application.

Applicants must demonstrate, through supporting documentation. evidence of excellence, achievement and involvement across the following fields of endeavour:

- Training and Experience in Dance or Theatre or Visual Arts
- Academic
- Active leadership and service to school community

Application Process

- 1. Register for the academic scholarship test with Edutest.
- 2. Complete this application form.
- 3. The academic scholarship test will be held from 4pm to 7pm on Tuesday 26 March 2024.
- 4. Completed application form and supporting information on levels of excellence, achievement and involvement must be uploaded through the Edutest portal. NOTE: A link to the portal and confirmation of registration will be emailed directly from Edutest once applicants have registered to sit the aademic scholarship test.

Required Documents Include:

- 1. Completed application form including:
 - Two references one academic and one personal. For example, a reference that will provide support of the applicant's involvement in their chosen field/s; and
 - A 200-word statement handwritten by the student applicant outlining the reasons for applying and the ways they would be a positive addition to our School. Please include references to strengths in your chosen field/s of endeavour and how this would benefit Caulfield Grammar School.
- 2. Most recent (full semester) School report.
- 3. Most recent NAPLAN results.
- 4. Relevant certificates achieved in the last 12 months to support the application.
- 5. Additional requirements for chosen discipline, please see over.

Additional requirements for each discipline

Dance

Solo Dance Video. The solo dance video should be 2-3 minutes long and prepared in the applicant's preferred dance style to a song of their choice. Applicants are encouraged to showcase their technical and performance skills and demonstrate creativity and personal movement style. Videos should be unedited, and applicants are asked to perform for the camera as they would to a live audience within a school environment. This video should be uploaded to the Edutest portal with other supporting documents.

Audition. For shortlisted applicants only.

Theatre

Solo Monologue Video. Applicants are required to choose one monologue from 10 age-appropriate playscripts that include a range of theatrical styles and characters. To request the list of monologues, contact:

scholarships@caulfieldgs.vic.edu.au The solo monologue video should be 2-3 minutes long and unedited. Applicants are encouraged to showcase their acting and performance skills and demonstrate creativity and an understanding of the selected text. Applicants are asked to perform for the camera as they would to a live audience within a school environment. This video should be uploaded to the Edutest portal with other supporting documents.

Audition. For shortlisted applicants only.

Visual Arts

Folio. Applicants are required to present a folio consisting of four pieces. NOTE: a piece can consist of multiple parts or elements. Folio pieces should be uploaded to the Edutest port in digital format (coloured photographs, scans or files) with other supporting documents.

Practical and Theoretical Test. For shortlisted applicants only.
