

Application for General Excellence Scholarship

Applications close:

<u>Year 7</u> registrations for test close on 31 January 2024. Supporting documentation closes on 13 February 2024. <u>Years 9 & 10</u> registrations for test close on 13 March 2024. Supporting documenation closes on 26 March 2024.

Selection Criteria

General Excellence Scholarships for Years 7, 9 & 10 are open to applicants who are:

- New or currently enrolled students of Caulfield Grammar School; and
- A Citizen or Permanent Resident of Australia at the time of application.

Applicants must demonstrate, through supporting documentation, evidence of excellence, achievement and involvement across a minimum of three of the following fields of endeavour:

- Academic
- Active Leadership & Service to school community
- Sport Competing at a State/National level in an APS sport offered at Caulfield Grammar School
- The Arts (Performing and/or Visual Arts)

Applicants will sit an academic scholarship test. Shortlisted applicants will attend an interview.

Application Process

- 1. Register for the academic scholarship test with Edutest.
- 2. Complete this application form.
- 3. The academic scholarship test will be held at the Caulfield Campus:
 - a. on Saturday 10 February 2024 9:00am 12:00pm for entry in Year 7.
 - b. on Tuesday 26 March 2024 4:00pm 7:00pm for entry in Years 9 & 10.
- 4. Completed application form and supporting information on levels of excellence, achievement and involvement must be uploaded through the Edutest portal. NOTE: A link to the portal and confirmation of registration will be emailed directly from Edutest once applicants have registered to sit the academic scholarship test.

Required Documents Include:

- 1. Completed application form including:
 - Two references one academic and one personal i.e. a reference that will provide support of the applicant's involvement in their chosen field/s; and
 - A 200-word statement handwritten by the student applicant outlining the reasons for applying and the ways
 they would be a positive addition to our school community. Please include references to strengths in your
 chosen field/s of endeavour and how this would benefit Caulfield Grammar School.
- 2. Most recent (full semester) School Report.
- 3. Most recent NAPLAN results.
