

# Our School Motto and Crest

#### The School Motto

Our School Motto, *Labora Ut Requiescas*, was chosen by Reverend Joseph Henry Davies, the Founder of Caulfield Grammar School and first Headmaster 1881-1888.

Today the meaning is 'Work hard that you may rest content', which inspires us to persevere in achieving the goals of truth and knowledge represented by the star on the School Crest, surmounting the shield of faith and protection.

# **The School Crest**

Our School Crest shows an open book representing the Bible. Surrounding it is the Belt of Knowledge with seven stars representing the seven liberal arts and seven liberal virtues.

The Motto, Labora Ut Requiescas, is written inside the Crest. Above the Crest is a torse, a heraldic twist of cloth or wreath separating and giving prominence to the star.

The seven liberal virtues represent prudence, justice, temperance, courage, faith, hope, and charity. The seven liberal arts, or sciences of Trivium and Quadrivium, are grammar, logic, rhetoric, music, geometry, arithmetic, and astronomy.

Formed 1981. Named in honour of Mr Herbert McDonnell Shaw, past student, 1914 to 1923, and Past Emeritus President of School Council.

Formed 2023. Named in honour of Anna Skarbek (Class of 1993), the first female Dux of Caulfield Grammar School.

Formed 1981. Named in honour of Norman T. M. Wilsmore, past student, 1882 to 1885, and first School Dux in 1882 and Dux of 1883.

Named in honour of Miss Jessie Brown, senior primary teacher at Caulfield Grammar School from 1920 to 1957.

# **Barnett House**

Formed 1923. Named in honour of Archdeacon Ernest J. Barnett MA – Second Headmaster of Caulfield Grammar School, 1888 to 1896.

# **Morcom House**

Formed 1958 as School House, renamed in 1966. Named in honour of Mr William S. Morcom OBE – a past Chief of Staff and teacher at Caulfield Grammar School from 1911 to 1961.

**Colour**: Tangerine **Emblem**: Eagle **Motto**: *Certemus* – Let us Strive



# **Buntine House**

Originally Lyle House, renamed 1931. Named in honour of Mr Walter M. Buntine MA – Third Headmaster of Caulfield Grammar School, from 1896 to 1931.

**Colour:** Green **Emblem:** Dragon **Motto:** *Buntinus Semper Vincit* – Buntine Always Conquers



# **Newton House**

Formed 2012. Named in honour of Mr Stephen H. Newton AO – Eighth Principal of Caulfield Grammar School, 1993 to Term 1, 2011.

Colour: Sky Blue Emblem: Lion

# **Syme House**

Formed 2023. Named in honour of Reverend Andrew P. Syme – Ninth Principal of Caulfield Grammar School,

Term 2, 2011 to 2017.

Colour: Maroon

Emblem: A mountain path Motto: Go Far, Go Well

Formed 1923. Named in honour of Rev. Joseph H. Davies MA – Founder and First Headmaster of Caulfield Grammar School. 1881 to 1888.
